



IJBCA Scholarship Application

This scholarship program was established to encourage young people to find a way to fit cattle into their careers. Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to students who are already in college and two \$500 scholarships will be given to two seniors in high school. The scholarship is sponsored by the IJBCA and the IBCA. Recipients can only receive each scholarship once.

To apply for one scholarship being awarded, each applicant must qualify under the following rules and criteria:

1. Completed applications must be postmarked by **January 1, 2009** and mailed to the following address: 2925 Horizon Drive #3, West Lafayette, IN 47096.
2. Application must be typed. Handwritten application will not be eligible for judging.
3. Applicant must be a member of the Indiana Junior Beef Cattle Association (IJBCA) in good standing.
4. Applicant must have at least a C grade point average at the time of application. Please provide a transcript of your grades with the application.
5. Applicant must be actively or intending on pursuing a degree at a college or university.
6. Applicant must be 21 years of age or younger as of January 1 of the application year.
7. Scholarships will be awarded at the 2009 Indiana Beef Cattle Association annual convention.
8. Awards will be paid directly to the recipient upon proof of enrollment.
9. An essay on "Back Where I Come From" will be worth 50% in the determination of the scholarship recipients. The remaining 50% will be based on IJBCA activities, leadership activities and livestock knowledge. Please write the essay as it pertains to your involvement with beef cattle.
